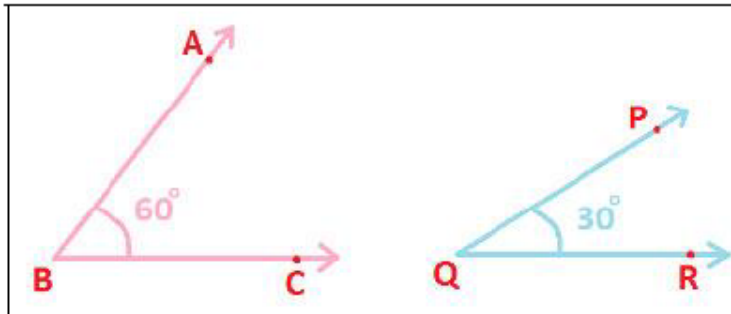


Complementary Angles



These angles have a sum of 90° .
They form a right angle.
 $m\angle ABC + m\angle PQR = 90^\circ$

Definition of Supplementary/Definition of Complementary – says that

- ✓ “If two angles are supplementary,
then their measures add up to 180 degrees.”

- ✓ “If two angles are complementary,
then their measures add up to 90 degrees.”
